

General Use Guidelines

Welcome to Linnaea Farm! We ask all of our guests to respect the property and buildings while on the farm, and that those visiting Linnaea are in agreement with the following guidelines:

Parking & Unloading

Please park in the Linnaea Farm general parking area, which is the parking lot you see as soon as you drive in off of Seaford Road. Once parked, you'll see there is a large wooden map of the property, and a road leading away from the parking area to the Education Centre, which is the main building at Linnaea Farm.

If you have larger items to unload that are difficult to carry, you are welcome to drive up to the building and unload, and then drive back to park in the main lot. When driving on the road from the parking lot to the Education Centre, the speed limit is 5km / hour, as we have children and dogs playing in that area.

As you walk in along the road, please be mindful that Linnaea is a public and private space, and that there are residents living on the property.

Entering the Education Centre

Please take your shoes off before entering the building. There might be events in progress, so please make sure to move through the spaces quietly and respectfully.

Fire & Safety

Fire extinguishers can be found inside the front door on the right hand side. First aid kits can be found in the 1st bathroom in the cabinet under the sink. There is a landline hanging on the wall to the right of the bathrooms, if there is an emergency, please dial 911. **The address for the Education Center is 1255 Seaford Rd.**

Noise

As we have many families living on the farm, there is a farm wide quiet time that begins at 10pm each night.

Pets

All visiting dogs must be on leash at all times.
